# 1970 UNIFORM CODE

### 1. GIRLS' UNIFORM AND REGULATIONS:

### Summer:

- a. Tunics: dark green-Tootals U 90/1076 (material)' (Paulette pattern 571 no waist); (Paulette pattern 525 with waist).
- b. Blouses: White short sleeved, rever collar, open
- c. Sockettes: White. To be worn turned down
- d. Shoes: Mid-brown lace up. At least three lace holes each side.
- e. Rompers: Britway bottle-green (5408 Simplicity pattern) (2941 Academy pattern)
- f. Cardigans: (Optional); Dark green, vee neck.

Cardigans buttoned to the neck are not uniform. Cardigans are Not street wear.

- g. Blazers: (Compulsory), Dark green
- h. Raincoats: Grey. Dark oil-skin may be worn. Raincoats of regulation style and colour for a previous school may be worn until a replacement is needed.

### Winter:

- a. Gym Dress: Mid-Grey
- b. Blouses: White-rever collar, done up.
- c. Ties: Green with thin gold diagonal stripes.
- d. Socks: Three-quarter length grey (woolen)

# **Sixth form Girls:**

### Summer:

- a. Skirt; Black watch tartan, Box pleats (55% terylene, 45% wool, drip dry)
- b. Blouse: Patterns obtainable from school of C.C. Wards Ltd.
- c. Stockings: Seam-free-natural shades
- d. Rompers, Cardigans, Blazers, Raincoats, berets, etc., as for the rest of the school.

Shoes: An approved style for 6th formers.

#### Winter:

- a. Skirt as for summer
- b. Blouse: White long sleeve, rever collar-done up
- c. Ties: Green with gold diagonal stripes.

## **School Regulations:**

- 1. All uniform clothing must be named. Please be most particular about naming clothing in an indelible way.
- 2. a. Hair must be neat, tidy and off the collar in a suitable style
  - b. Bottle green bands or ribbons may be worn
  - c. Plain brown plastic clips may be used to fasten back hair.
  - d. Hair clips are not permitted to be worn on the front of tunics.
- 3. No jewellery is permitted. The only badges permitted are Duke of Edinburgh, Crusaders, School prefect and Bus prefect.
- 4. Fingernails: a. No polish is permitted
  - b. Nails are to be worn no longer than the ends of the finger because of the danger in sport and Physical Education.
- 5. Rompers: These are to be named on the right hand side, one inch below the waist band on the outside of the garment with a length of white tape. This is to prevent unauthorized borrowing of rompers.
- 6. School Bags: Should be of green, brown, black or navy but not of other bright colours. Bags are for sale at school in two styles- zipped and grip, both priced at \$4-50.
